The post will be full-time for a fixed term of 12 months. The successful applicant will be responsible for a range of duties including (but not limited to)

- Organising meetings and events for students/young workers to build friendships and equip them for Christian life
- Meeting one to one with young people for prayer and Bible Study
- Developing links with Christian Unions and other Christian youth organisations
- Supporting work with international students
- Leading youth outreach work in the local community
- Working alongside the Family & Community Worker to build community links
- Developing a programme of events for teenagers in the congregation

With previous experience in youth work or student outreach, you will be self-motivated and able to work on your own initiative and as part of a team. You will be sensitive in approach with the ability to build trusting relationships and will possess excellent organisational and communications skills.

In accordance with the Equality Act 2010, there is a Genuine Occupational Requirement that the job holder is a practising Christian with a vibrant and active Christian faith. You will be involved in implementing decisions integral to the furtherance of the congregation's mission and it is therefore essential that applicants are sympathetic to the mission and ethos of the Free Church of Scotland.
